OBJECTIVES



To support excellent Principal Investigators (PI) at the career stage at which they may still be consolidating their own independent research team or programme.

CRITERIA



Applications can be made in any field of research. ERC's grants operate on a "bottom-up" basis.

BENEFICIARIES



ERC grants support projects carried out by an individual researcher who can employ researchers of any nationality as team members.

- Researchers of any nationality with 7-12 years of experience since completion of PhD (prior to 1 January 2024). Cut-off dates: Successful defence of PhD between 1 January 2012 and 31 December 2016 (inclusive).
- Eligibility can be extended for reasons such as maternity, paternity, illness, national service, training, natural disasters, or asylum.

CANDIDATES REQUIREMENTS



- Evidence of research independence.
- Scientific track record showing great promise and an excellent research proposal can apply: having produced several important publications as main author or without the participation of their PhD supervisor
- PI must demonstrate the ground-breaking nature, ambition, and feasibility of their research proposal.
- PI can be hosted by any legal entity in an EU Member State or associated country.
- Minimum time commitment: PI must spend a 40% of their working time on the ERC project, and a 50% in a Member State or Associated Country

BUDGET



The total budget is € 584 million.

- May be awarded up to € 2 million.
- An additional € 1 million can be made available to cover eligible "start-up" costs for researchers moving from a third country to the EU or an associated country and/or the purchase of major equipment and/or access to large facilities and/or other major experimental and field work costs.

PROPOSAL SCORING & THRESHOLDS



Those proposals that do not obtain a minimum grade will not be able to be resubmitted in the next call.

- 2022 and 2023 Call: Rejected on the grounds of a breach of research integrity.
 - In 2022 call: C at Step 1
- In 2023 call: A or B at Step 2 and B or C at Step 1

A maximum of 44 proposals per panel will be assessed at step 2 of the evaluation. Moreover, a distinction in the scoring at step 1 will be made between proposals obtaining a score of A and invited to step 2 of the evaluation, and proposals obtaining a score of A but not ranked sufficiently high to be invited to step 2.

An applicant PI, whose proposal has been selected for funding and who is preparing a grant agreement under a 2023 ERC call, may not apply for the 2024 ERC call

ELIGIBLE EXPENSES



An ERC grant can cover up to 100% of the total eligible direct costs of the research plus a contribution of 25% of the total eligible costs towards indirect costs.

DURATION
